Time Out Hotel is committed to working with our community. We recognize the importance of the impacts of our business, our staff and our neighbourhood. We commit that our business will have a positive impact for our local community. Time Out Hotel also ensures that it manages its use of water, energy and chemicals in order to safeguard our neighbours and our beautiful island.

Time Out Hotel supports a local charity in Barbados called the Variety Club, also known as the Children's charity of Barbados. The Charity is dedicated to improving the lives of our children who are mentally, physically or socially disadvantaged. The Aunty Olga Memorial School Aid Program, supported by the Variety Club provides school uniforms, books, backpacks, and school supplies to over 300 children from 200 families across Barbados, giving them an equal opportunity at education.

In 2018, we provided the Variety club with a staycation for two to support their Freedom for Kids programme which supports the Sunshine Coach, wheelchairs and other mobility devices for children with physical and mental challenges.

We also supported the Barbados Scoliosis Charity at a Spinathon 2018, Pedal for a Purpose: Scoliosis to raise funds for treatments to those persons with Scoliosis. Time Out also supported The Pride of Barbados Optimist Club Foundational Representative by providing drinks, Sun Group bags, Water Bottles and Glasses to the participants. Optimist International (OI) is an association that seeks to conduct positive service projects in the community aimed specifically at empowering young people 'to be the best that they can be'. Within OI there are several overarching foundations and one such foundation is the Club Foundational Arm with one of its functions being that of raising funds for the foundation.

Finally, Time Out's amazing team has also supported the Dover Playing Field and offered to cut their perimeter lawn that resides in front of our hotel, so that both they and the hotel have a neat and clean surrounding area.
