The hotel's daily operation is geared towards ecological preservation of the surrounding environment.

Our Goals:

- 1. To reduce our carbon emissions, water use and waste production by 10% before the end of July 2024 through implementing the following steps:
 - Regularly recording and monitoring the amount of energy and water we use, as well as the waste we produce
 - Installing low energy lighting throughout our property
 - Installing flow restrictors on all taps
 - Putting information in guest rooms about how to conserve energy, water and how to recycle their waste
 - Sourcing more sustainable products
 - Installing Solar Power Panels to generate Electricity
- 2. To minimise all forms of pollution from our business operations by implementing the following steps:
 - Wherever possible, continuously reviewing and replacing the cleaning chemicals we use with eco-friendly alternatives
 - Replacing refrigerators with ozone-friendly models by the end of 2024.
- 3. To have a positive impact on local community in our area by taking the following steps:
 - Continuing to support the Variety Club and the Aunty Olga Memorial School Aid Programme
 - Participating in annual fundraising activities for a local project
